

RESOLUTION 2007-6-4

RESOLUTION ORDERING ELECTION,
REQUESTING COUNTY ELECTIONS TO CONDUCT THE ELECTION
REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF THE ELECTION, AND
SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

SALTON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Election Code Section 10002, the governing body of the Salton Community Services District may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors of the county to permit the county elections official to render specified services to the district relating to the conduct of an election;

WHEREAS, the resolution of the district shall specify the services requested; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to elections Code Section 10400, whenever two or more elections, including bond elections, of any legislative or congressional district, public district, city, county, or other political subdivision are called to be held on the same day, in the same territory, or in territory that is in part the same, they may be consolidated upon the order of the governing body or bodies or officer or officers calling the elections; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10403, whenever an election called by a district, city or other political subdivision for the submission of any question, proposition, or office to be filled is to be consolidated with a statewide election, and the question, proposition, or office to be filled is to appear upon the same ballot as that provided for that statewide election, the district, city or other political subdivision shall, at least 88 days prior to the date of the election, file with the board of supervisors, and a copy with the elections official, a resolution of its governing Board requesting the consolidation, and setting forth the exact form of any questions, proposition, or office to be voted upon at the election, as it is to appear on the ballot. Upon such request, the Board of Supervisors may order the consolidation; and

WHEREAS, the resolution requesting the consolidation shall be adopted and filed at the same time as the adoption of the ordinance, resolution, or order calling the election; and

WHEREAS, various district, county, and statewide and other political subdivision elections have been or may be called to be held on November 6, 2007;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED THAT the Governing Board of the Salton Community Services District hereby orders and election to be called and consolidated with any and all elections also called to be held on November 6, 2007 insofar as said elections are to be held in the same territory or in territory that is in part the same as the territory of the Salton Community Services District request to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Imperial to order such consolidation under Election Code Section 10400; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said district board hereby requests the Board of Supervisors to permit the Imperial County Election Department to provide any and all services necessary for conducting the election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that pursuant to Elections Code Section 5322, the authority for the specifications of the election order, the Governing Body of the Salton Community Services District hereby orders an election to be held with the following specification:

The election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2007;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Imperial County Elections Department conduct the election for the following offices on the November 6, 2007 ballot:

SEATS OPEN	OFFICE	TERM
Two	Director	four-year term

No election will be held if there is insufficient number of nominees.

The qualifications of a nominee of an elective officer of the Salton Community Services District are as follows:

Registered voter in the district and residing in the district.

The Candidate's Statement of Qualifications shall be paid for by the candidate. A current map showing the boundaries of the Salton Community Services District is attached.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Imperial County Elections Department is requested to print the measure text exactly as filed by the Voter's information pamphlet section of the sample ballot for the November 6, 2007 election. Cost of printing and distribution of the measure text will be paid for by the district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Imperial County Elections Department is ordered that in the event of a tie vote, the candidates will be selected by lot.


