

Mangers Report for June 19, 2007

May 25, Bid advertisements were prepared to be displayed in the Imperial Valley press and the Desert Sun on 5/31/07 and 6/7/07 with bid opening date and award or reject date to also be set in that advertisement

.June 11, This day I meet with Bob Ridley who is an professional Soccer player in the American league and has helped put together several large Soccer parks. After our old ponds are dried up and the sludge is removed, we will level the ground and create a forty acre park. At least a portion of that park will be a Soccer park. This park can be irrigated by reclaimed sewer water via an 8 inch pipe line that will be installed at the same time as the 12 inch line to transport sewage to the new treatment facility. As we grow this 8 inch line can supply irrigation water for a lot of various things. Bob Ridley will give us much needed guidance.

June 12. Bid opening for the new sewer treatment facility and pipe line to it has been rescheduled to July 12 at 10 am and award of contract to be at the July 17th Board meeting.

June 13 On this day Bob Butler, Rosa, and Myself met with Stella Mendoza and Jim Kelly of I.I.D. to start negotiations to renew the Districts Shoreline lease with their Agency. The existing lease expires in October 2009 and without a renewal we will lose the golf course, the dry camp the nature trail and Johnsons RV Park and restaurant.

The meeting went well and we will appear before their board for discussion November 13 2007 and in December for their approval if all goes well.
